GNLU Silvassa Campus Admissions 2025 Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. Where is GNLU Silvassa Campus located?

GNLU-Silvassa Campus (GNLUS) is located in the Union Territory of Dadra Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu (DNHDD). The UT is at the border of Gujarat and Maharashtra. To know more about the Union Territory, visit https://ddd.gov.in/

2. How to reach Silvassa?

By Air- The nearest airport to Silvassa is the Surat International Airport (150kms). The Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport, Mumbai is also only 167 km away from Silvassa.

By Train- The nearest railway station to Silvassa is Vapi Railway Station, Gujarat which is around 22 kms away from Silvassa.

3. What courses are offered at GNLUS?

GNLUS offers a five-year undergraduate degree of B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) and a one-year post-graduate degree of LL.M. in Constitutional & Administrative Law specialisation.

4. What is the process of admission to GNLU-S?

Admission to GNLUS is offered to candidates based on Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) administered by the Consortium of NLUs. The national-level exam is held in December of the previous academic year. For further details regarding CLAT, please visit https://consortiumofnlus.ac.in/

5. What is seat intake for UG and PG programme?

There are a total of 66 Seats for the UG Programme and 33 seats for the PG Programme.

6. What is the annual fee structure?

9. Where are the hostel and college located?

10. Are there any transportation facilities available?

There is a regular Bus facility available to travel between the Hostel and College Campus. The University also has tie-ups with travel agencies for providing safe movement of students from Hostel to nearest Railway Station/Airport at a cost.

11. What about Hostel Facilities?

This Hostel is your home away from home. Choosing a university is also about choosing a new home. We ensure that students dwell in a healthy environment that helps them to grow and learn without any obstacles. GNLUS Campus has separate hostels for boys and girls with all modern facilities. There is a common air-conditioned mess for the students. There are also air-conditioned reading rooms and recreational rooms in both Hostels for the students. Students are not permitted to keep in their possession - room crackers, dangerous weapons, firearms, contraband items or - instruments that can cause serious injury to others. The hostel accommodation for PG students is in a different building.

We have 24*7 Wardens/Matrons and Security Guards in the hostel to ensure safety of our children. We also have a dedicated housekeeping staff to maintain the hostels. Laundry services are available at a minor cost. All essential services (fruit sellers, stationary, eateries, chemist, tailor, confectionary, etc.) are available within 100m radius of the Hostel.

12. What are the Sports facilities?

The students have complete access to the Silvassa Sports Complex which is just 100m away from the Hostel. Students get an annual membership via which they can avail a range of facilities including gym, swimming pool, chess, table tennis, cricket, basketball, yoga, marathon running, etc. The University also has a dedicated Sports coach to help students pursue their passion towards any sport.

13. What are the library facilities available?

The GNLUS library aims to become a repository of knowledge and research. It aims to establish an excellent library to act as a legal hub for anyone and everyone interested in legal research and reference. It also supports the teaching, learning and research needs of GNLUS scholars, students and faculty by providing a rich collection of the world's legal literature. We have an exhaustive elibrary which has access to a comprehensive list of resources and the campus library has varied range of books, articles, journals, etc. The library is open from 9AM - 9PM Monday-Friday, with extended timings during examinations. We also have RFID, Pathfinders, Similarity Checking, and other Document Delivery Services, etc.

14. What are the Mess timings?

There are separate utensils for cooking and serving non-vegetarian food.

15. Are GNLU Silvassa and GNLU Gandhinagar different?

GNLU Silvassa Campus and GNLU Gandhinagar Campus are just two different campuses under the same umbrella of Gujarat National Law University. We follow the same curriculum structure and same academic calendar. Students and Faculties from both the Campuses often visit the other campus.

16. What about medical facilities?

The University has a 24*7 nurse and on-call doctor to attend to any medical emergencies. We have an infirmary in the Hostel as well as the Academic Block. We also have contacts with the local civil and private/multispecialty hospitals to address any concerns.

17. Is there a dress code?

There is no prescribed dress code for hostels. For Campus, you must be dressed in a presentable and professional manner. On Mondays and Fridays, students are required to wear black & white. Since law students often visit District Courts & High Courts, Moot Court Competitions, and other competitions in other law schools across the country; therefore, it is suggested that you should have one formal pair of white shirt, black pant, and black coat.

18. How is campus life in GNLU-S?

The campus life at our college is vibrant and enjoyable. We enjoy good food, have a spacious library for studying, a lively garden area in front of the academic building for events, and a sports complex nearby making it an enjoyable experience.
